



GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS IN WIND CONDUCTING

Department of Music

POSITIONS:	Graduate Assistantships available to conduct and perform with the Oklahoma State University Bands.
RESPONSIBILITIES:	Service to the band area will include ensemble conducting, athletic bands, and general office procedures.
STIPENDS:	Up to \$10,451.00 per academic year, 32 credit hours of tuition waived for the master's degree, and out-of-state tuition remission for any additional hours taken.
QUALIFICATIONS:	Bachelor's Degree in Music and admission to the Graduate College. Previous teaching experience is preferred, but not required.
DEGREE:	Master of Music in Conducting
APPLICATION:	Applicants must audition / interview on campus. Admission to the Graduate College is required for consideration. Applications will be reviewed on a continuing basis until positions are filled. Early application is encouraged.
OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY:	The university, with approximately 25,000 students at the main campus in Stillwater, is located about 65 miles from Tulsa and Oklahoma City. The Music Department has twenty-six full-time and twelve part-time faculty members and is accredited by the NASM. In addition to the Master of Music, the Department offers the degrees of Bachelor of Music (with options in music education, performance, or business) and Bachelor of Arts. OSU is an equal opportunity affirmative action employer.

Oklahoma State University Bands include the Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, Concert Band, Chamber Winds, Jazz Ensembles, the 300-member Cowboy Marching Band and two Spirit Bands. The Wind Ensemble has performed for conventions of the College Band Directors National Association, World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, Japan Band Clinic, British Association of Symphonic Bands and Wind Ensembles, National Band Association, Percussive Arts Society, Sonneck Society, and the Oklahoma Music Educators Association.
